WHO ARE ABLE TREK TRAVELERS?

Individuals who need assistance vacationing are encouraged and welcome to travel with Able Trek Tours. This includes individuals with developmental disabilities, the elderly, individuals with a mental health condition, and others. Most Travelers are individuals with mild to moderate developmental disabilities. Travelers must exhibit appropriate social behavior, have no major medical concerns, be at least 18 years old, and display appropriate behavior toward property, themselves and others. Typical staff to Traveler ratios are 1:3 or 1:4. If a Traveler requires more assistance and/or supervision we MUST be informed of such needs ahead of time. In some instances, travelers may require 1:1

staffing or their own home staff to accompany them.

TRIP FEES INCLUDE

Staff supervision, transportation from pick-up/drop-off sites, listed attractions, lodging, taxes, an Able Trek t-shirt, bag, or hat, a group photo, and many meals are included in the trip fee. Almost every trip includes breakfast and the evening meal each day.

TRAVELERS USING WHEELCHAIRS:



We have accommodations for up to two Travelers who use wheelchairs on most trips. It is our experience that nearly all Travelers who use a wheelchair require Traveler specific, "specialized" care. Their caregivers must be both physically capable of and trained in the techniques of transferring and lifting. In addition, most Travelers who utilize wheelchairs have very individual and specific personal care needs. which can only be

properly met by a caregiver who has experience with that Traveler. In order to properly and safely accommodate Travelers who use wheelchairs, we have adopted the following policy:

- 1) Travelers who require mobility related care and/or need any assistance transferring are REQUIRED to provide their own caregiver who is familiar with their cares and needs. Travelers who require assistance transferring (toileting, dressing, bedtime, etc.) are welcome to travel but ONLY accompanied by their own personal caregiver. Able Trek staff are not permitted to lift Travelers or assist with transferring. This is a non-negotiable policy. Providing inaccurate or incomplete information about a travelers mobility/transferring need will result in the Traveler not being allowed to travel and no refund will be available. To help make this policy more affordable, the personal caregiver will travel at ½ the cost for most trips. The Traveler will pay the single/ADA rate (see #2 below) and the caregiver's trip fee will be 50% of that rate. For trip 1:1 pricing please contact our office. The Traveler, who will have an ADA room, will be located next to or very close to their staff. The staff person will likely room with an Able Trek Tours staff unless a second private room is purchased at the time of reservation. If an ADA room is not needed the staff will room with their traveler. This 50% fee policy applies to virtually all tours with the possible exception of flight and/or international vacations. Call us for exact prices.
- 2) Travelers who require fully accessible lodging accommodations (roll-in shower, wide door entrances, grab bars in bathroom, etc.) are required to pay the "Single/ADA" rate. The reason for this policy is that the vast majority of ADA

accessible hotel rooms have only one bed. Two people are not able to sleep in these rooms and still have their own private beds.

TRAVELER INCONTINENCE:

We understand that when outside of normal routines and home settings travelers may have occasional/accidental incontinence. For travelers that have frequent incontinence or have little or no bowel or bladder control and are not able to self-manage would be REQUIRED to bring their own home staff. This policy is to ensure the most qualified person is providing the specialized care required. To help make this policy more affordable, the personal caregiver will travel at ½ the cost for most trips. The Traveler will pay the double rate and the caregiver's trip fee will be 50% of that rate. For trips involving air or cruise ship travel, the cost may be higher. Contact the office for 1:1 pricing for specific trips.

STAFFING ON TOURS

Every vacation is supervised by an experienced Tour Leader. Our core staff members/chaperones are carefully screened and selected volunteers. Many of our volunteer staff are social workers, teachers, group home staffers, medical professionals, and other qualified and experienced people.

Typical staff to Traveler ratio is 1:3 or 1:4. If a Traveler requires more assistance and/or supervision we MUST be informed of this need ahead of time. Please be aware that care/supervision on vacations is typically more intensive or demanding than in the home setting. We will do our best to accommodate a Traveler's needs in excess of our normal staff supervision. If a Traveler requires 1:1 supervision an extra fee will be required. In some instances, we will require that Travelers bring their own staff. As stated previously, this is the policy with Travelers who use a wheelchair to ambulate and/or require physical assistance to transfer.

Travelers who are unable to independently take themselves to the restroom, or follow the group without assistance may be required to have 1:1 staffing. This ensures that we are caring for all needs of our travelers keeping safety at the forefront. In many cases Able Trek Tours is able to provide 1:1 staffing. Travelers needing an escort or assistance in the restroom and are staffed by Able Trek Tours will be assigned a staff of the same gender.

PERSONAL ESCORTS

At times Travelers and caregivers simply do not feel comfortable attending a vacation without a familiar face along. This situation has been common for Travelers who may need more assistance than our normal 1:3/4 ratio and for Travelers who use a wheelchair. We welcome, encourage, and will at times require that personal caregivers join us. The cost for such an arrangement (for BOTH participants) is typically 150% or 1 ½ times the cost of the indicated rate. This would include a standard hotel room with two beds. Please call for guaranteed prices.

GROUP HOME STAFF: – Group home staff, caregivers, case managers, etc. if you sign three or more people up for a trip you can go as their chaperone. If you are planning to staff your own travelers this needs to be communicated at the time the travelers are signed up for the trip. Contact Able Trek Tours for more information.

TRAVEL/CANCELLATION INSURANCE COVERAGE

Travel insurance, for an additional fee, is available for all tours. Please refer to our Able Trek Tours website to learn about insurance coverage, costs and how to purchase a policy for each individual trip. All travel insurance purchases will be done through the link on our website. We can also email you a link to this insurance information. Coverage includes trip cancellation, emergency medical/dental, and more. For pre-existing conditions to be covered the insurance MUST be purchased within 14 days of the initial trip deposit/payment. Rates generally range between 12 % and 20% of the trip cost.

SPEND DOWN – Not sure of the exact trip you want to take? You can send payment(s) in advance and decide on a trip later. Be sure to indicate "future travel" on your check when mailing in payments if you have not yet decided on a trip.

GIFT CERTIFICATES – Give the gift of travel. We have gift certificates available for any dollar amount. Contact our office for details.

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR TRIPS

WE ARE NO LONGER UTILIZING FAX, SO ANY DOCUMENTS SENT VIA THE OLD FAX NUMBER WILL NOT BE RECEIVED. PLEASE MAIL OR EMAIL ALL DOCUMENTS

Let us know which trip(s) you are interested in and we will send you a tentative itinerary and any necessary application materials. Reservations will be held for 10 working days. By the 10th day we require a \$100 per trip deposit to confirm a spot (flight, cruise and international trips REQUIRE a minimum \$500 deposit). Unless the deposit/payment has been received or other arrangements are made the "reservation" will be cancelled after 10 days.

- One month prior to the trip a FINAL ITINERARY will be sent confirming all details and requesting any additional information needed.
- Shortly after the vacation a Trip Report and group photo will be sent.

Trips are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis and many vacations sell out. It is important to sign-up as soon as possible. We suggest a minimum of 60 days for motor coach and a minimum of 3 months for air & international vacations.

Trips must be paid in full by the PAY IN FULL DUE DATE indicated as this is when final payments are made to airlines, hotels, and venues with traveler names. If a traveler is not paid in full by this date, we reserve the right to remove the traveler from the trip after notification.

IMPORTANT BOOKKEEPING REQUIREMENT:

Many Travelers make monthly payments. Make sure to indicate the Traveler's name and TRIP TITLE (e.g. "Just Fish'n") with all payments.

GETTING THERE IS HALF THE FUN

All of Able Trek Tours' motor coaches are equipped with TV monitors, DVD/CD player, electrical outlets and/or USB, bathroom, air-conditioning and plenty of room to stretch your legs. All of our bus leads and Tour Leaders have cell phones. The cell numbers are indicated on the FINAL ITINERARIES.





ACCOMMODATION/SLEEPING OPTIONS

Overnight accommodations on most trips are well known hotel chains. We offer options with regard to sleeping arrangements. They are:

DOUBLE ROOM - Two people per hotel room, each person has a private bed.

SINGLE ROOM – Private hotel room with no roommates.

Prices for each type of room are indicated in the tour descriptions. The prices indicated are per person. Travelers MUST let us know their accommodation choice when making the reservation and/or by indicating such on the Traveler application. Over 95% of the Travelers choose the DOUBLE ROOM option. Single room availability is limited and is granted first come, first serve.

While our staff will monitor and assist all Travelers, direct 24-hour supervision (a staff in each room) is not feasible. Travelers will almost always room with another traveler. Travelers' rooms are typically adjacent or near a staff member's room. We reserve the right to place a staff member in any room if we deem it necessary.

If a traveler requires an ADA room they must book a SINGLE room, as hotel ADA rooms with roll in showers typically have only one bed.

MEALS AND SPENDING MONEY

Most multi-day trips often will include two meals per day. The number of meals included will be indicated on the trip itinerary. Meals not included will be paid for with the Traveler's personal spending money. If needed, our staff will assist Travelers to manage



their spending money. The amount of suggested personal spending money for each trip is indicated on the detailed itinerary. Some venues only take cash (denominations of \$20 or less) while others are cashless. We recommend Travelers bring a combination of cash and credit or debit cards. The recommend amount listed in itineraries typically will cover their meals and a small amount for souvenirs, if the travelers like to shop we recommend sending additional funds.



WHAT TO PACK

Travelers are allowed only one suitcase and one carryon bag. A large plastic garbage bag is helpful to use for dirty clothes inside the suitcase. Following is a suggested packing list:

General List:

Clothes:

- * Photo SMART ID card (Airline travel)* One clean set of clothing for each day
- * Passport Book (International/ Cruise) * Comfortable walking shoes
- * Medications (one additional day)
- * Camera for traveler use
- * Sun glasses
- * Toiletries, including sunscreen
- * Jacket, sweatshirt or sweater
- * Pajamas
- * Swim suit

Travelers need to bring all necessary toiletries and personal items as trips do not typically visit locations to purchase forgotten items.

For airline travel the actual ID must be given to staff at the time of pick up. No photocopies will be accepted for travel.

Recommend rolling suitcases as travelers do need to carry their bags and many have difficulties carrying duffel bags.

- 7) Limited departure and return locations.



VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

An experienced Tour Escort leads all of Able Trek Tours vacations. Other staff members are volunteers. Each volunteer chaperone assists a group of three to four Travelers. With the assistance of the Tour Leader, chaperones provide supervision to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for each Traveler. In exchange, volunteer chaperones go on the trip FREE and receive some meal money. If you or someone you know would enjoy supporting our Travelers as they break down travel barriers and expand their horizons – please reach out to our office to learn how to apply. We always welcome and are looking for dedicated, hardworking & compassionate volunteers.

PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

A PASSPORT is **REQUIRED** to travel anywhere outside the United States - this includes Canada and Mexico. A **PASSPORT BOOK** (about \$130) allows you to travel internationally via any means (air, land, water). A **PASSPORT CARD** (about \$30) allows travel internationally by LAND ONLY. If you have any plans to travel outside the United States, we suggest you start the process of securing a passport. The process is easy, but it will take up to 8 weeks, so don't delay. To apply for either type of passport log on to www.travel.state.gov or call 1-877-487-2778. Passports are valid for 10 years.

REAL I.D. REQUIREMENT

Beginning May 7, 2025 in order to fly anywhere within the United States and/or pass through airport security or visit federal buildings and military installations you <u>MUST</u> have a REAL I.D. (or have a valid Passport). If your driver's



license/state issued I.D. Card does not have a black or gold star in the upper right corner it is NOT a REAL I.D. Most DMV offices are equipped to issue the new REAL I.D. You will need to provide documents (passport, birth certificate, Social Security Card) to obtain the REAL I.D. Visit www.tsa.gov/real-id for specific details.

TRAVEL & TRIP CANCELLATION INSURANCE

Although insurance is not required to attend a vacation, we recommend that Travelers consider purchasing Travel/Cancellation Insurance. We especially encourage Travel Insurance for any trip including air, cruise, train or international travel. These particular vacations have very restrictive and expensive financial cancellation penalties. Cancellation insurance can protect your travel investment from unforeseeable events such as sickness, injury, or death of you, an immediate family member, or that of your traveling companion. In these cases, your trip payments can be fully refunded, minus the cost of the insurance. This can be great peace of mind and save you hundreds or thousands of dollars. Without

Travel Insurance you will be subject to the cancellation penalties indicated on page 23 of this booklet. The insurance also includes limited medical and emergency medical evacuation coverage during your vacation. For pre-existing conditions to be covered the insurance MUST be purchased within 14 days of the initial trip deposit/payment.

The cost of the Travel Insurance varies depending upon which plan you choose, but ranges between 12% and 20% of the total trip cost. To purchase or to receive more detailed information about the Travel and Cancellation coverage please see our website (www.abletrektours.com) or contact Able Trek Tours. For coverage of any pre-existing medical conditions the insurance MUST be purchased within 14 days of your initial trip deposit or payment.

POLICIES & INFORMATION

SMOKING POLICY

Participants may smoke only on planned rest stops and during designated free times in allowable areas. There is absolutely no smoking in vehicles or in hotel/motel rooms. Most attractions we visit have no smoking policies. If you have questions about smoking area availability on a trip, please contact the office. Many theme parks, stadiums, and large venues do not allow smoking on property.

ALCOHOL POLICY

The consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited by both Travelers and staff alike. This uniform policy is required for the safety and wellbeing of all participants.

ILLNESS / INJURY

If a participant becomes ill or injured and cannot continue to travel with the group, and requires transportation home, the participant will be responsible for such transportation costs. Travel insurance can be purchased for an additional fee. Information can be found on our website.

PROPERTY DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION

Participants who, intentionally or unintentionally damage or destroy property not belonging to themselves, are financially responsible for repair or replacement of the property. Able Trek Tours, our staff and volunteers accept no financial responsibility for damaged or destroyed property.

MEDICATION DISPENSING

All non-self medicating participant's medications and prescriptions must be individually pre-packaged according to the time and date of each dispensing. The guardian/parents/care staff/are responsible for making sure this is completed accurately. **Medications should not be packed in a Traveler's suitcase.** An extra day's supply of medications must be sent in case of emergency or trip delay. All medications will be surrendered to the Tour Director or person responsible for dispensing the medications at the time of check-in. Travelers who normally self medicate can continue this practice on trips and package their medications in the way they are familiar with. Staff will not accept tackle boxes. Please do not send more than two extra days medications. If a traveler does not bring all necessary medication it would be the responsibility of home staff to have the medication sent to where the group will be staying. The group does not have the ability to go to a pharmacy to pick up medications.

APPLICATION PROCESS & ACCURACY POLICY

Each Traveler is required to have an up-to-date Application, Medical Evaluation/Physical, and Medical Consent / Waiver completed prior to attending any trip. All information provided to Able Trek Tours must be complete and accurate. Failure to provide accurate or complete information may result in

immediate dismissal from any travel program. In the event that Travelers information is incomplete or inaccurate such that the safety of the Traveler or others is compromised, the Traveler will be sent home at his/her own expense. NO REFUND will be granted for any portion of the remaining trip. The Medical Evaluation (Physical form) must be received by Able Trek Tours no later than 21 days prior to each trip. It must be completed and signed by a physician or physician's assistant. Medical Evaluations/Physical must be completed within 12 months of the trip. Not having the required paperwork submitted for a trip may result in the traveler being denied boarding the day of the trip.

If **documented** health and/or **documented** behavioral issues result in safety concerns for the participant, staff, other Travelers or persons in the community, the parent, guardian, care staff, etc. in cooperation with Able Trek Tours will provide/arrange to provide transportation home for the participant.

All consent and waiver signatures must be those of the legal guardian. The application will not be processed with unauthorized signatures. Participants should sign where indicated whether they are self-quardians or not.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Travel/Cancellation insurance can be purchased through Able Trek Tours to protect you if you are forced to cancel for a variety of reasons. It also includes coverage for some accidents and illnesses. We strongly encourage Travel Insurance, especially for any trip including air, cruise, train or international travel. Contact Able Trek Tours or see our website for more information and details.

CANCELLED TRIPS

Able Trek reserves the right to cancel any session (trip) due to insufficient registration. In the event of cancellation, Travelers will be offered first choice of available trips, or their fees will be refunded in full. Able Trek Tours reserves the right to make itinerary changes of attractions, venues when necessary.

PAYMENTS

A minimum deposit of \$100/motor coach trip is required within two weeks of signing up for each trip. Air, cruise and international trips REQUIRE a minimum \$500 deposit. Tours requiring a larger deposit will be indicated as such in the tour description. Do not mail application without deposit unless prior arrangements have been made with Able Trek Tours.

TRIP FEE POLICIES

A deposit, normally \$100 per trip, is due to firmly "hold" a spot on a vacation. The remaining trip fee balance is due TWO MONTHS PRIOR prior to the trip start date for motor coach tours and up to FOUR MONTHS prior to departure for international, rail, cruise or air travel vacations.

FUEL SURCHARGE & TRIP ALTERATIONS

In the event of rising fuel costs, and/or airfares, Able Trek Tours, Inc. reserves the right to add a surcharge, not to exceed 10% of the trip cost. Because of everchanging attractions, shows, schedules, etc., Able Trek Tours reserves the right to make substitutions and changes in the trips when necessary.

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS

Please note: Some vacations may have more restrictive cancellation policies and penalties. If this is the case it will be indicated on the trip itinerary. **Travelers who are "no shows" on the day of departure receive no refund whatsoever. Travelers who are "late" on the day of departure are considered no shows.**

Motor coach/land tours -

All monies paid will be refunded if notice of cancellation is received by Able Trek Tours 45 days or more prior to each trip start date. If notice of cancellation is received by Able Trek 44 days to 8 days prior to the trip start date, Able Trek will retain \$100 plus any monies Able Trek Tours is not able to get refunded from its suppliers. Cancellations received 7 days or less prior to the trip start date will not receive a refund.

Air, Rail, Cruise, and international tours –

All monies paid will be refunded if notice of cancellation is received by Able Trek Tours 90 days or more prior to each trip start date. Cancellations received 89 days or less prior to the trip start date will be charged 20% of the total trip fee plus any monies Able Trek is not able to get refunded from its suppliers.

TRAVELER IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

All Travelers should have a CURRENT (check expiration date) photo I.D. for every trip. Additional identification will be REQUIRED for trips that include air, rail, cruise or international travel. Specific I.D. requirements will be sent with each trip itinerary. Travelers who are refused boarding on any vacation due to lack of proper and current identification will not receive a refund. Any travel outside the United States, even Canada and Mexico, will require a passport book – NO EXCEPTIONS!!

CPAP TRAVEL: If a traveler has a CPAP machine for sleep apnea it must be carried as a carry on when traveling. Please do not put it in the suitcase. Distilled water for motorcoach trips can be carried on with the traveler or prior to the trip distilled water can be placed in a tightly sealed thermos for use. TSA approved water for CPAP machines can be purchased online through vendors such as Amazon. Gallons of water are not allowed by TSA, so they would not be permitted. If a traveler does not bring distilled water for their CPAP the traveler would need to use tap water and then wash the machine with vinegar when they return home. The group does not have the ability to purchase distilled water while traveling. At this time Disney Cruise Line does provide distilled water when aboard their ships free of charge. Staff should always be notified at pick up that a traveler has a CPAP. CPAP machines do not count as the allotted carry on for airlines, so a traveler would be able to have a small back pack in addition to their CPAP machine.

DAY TRIPS: A traveler on a day trip may want to bring a supper to eat on the bus as the returns times often fall after normal meal time and the group does not stop for supper on a one-day trip. If a traveler brings a supper meal because they have a late return, please remember we only allow bottled water on the motorcoaches. No soda, juice or flavored water. Eating on the bus is allowed only for these suppers on day trips. Please place an ice pack (or a frozen bottle of water) in a smaller soft sided cooler with their sandwich, labeled with their name. If a traveler does not bring their sandwich in a cooler, it may not be eaten for up to 12 hours, so the ice pack and cooler is necessary.

Trip Spending Money: Please do not send denominations larger than \$20 on any trip. Our first stops many times are fast food restaurants for lunches and they will not accept bills larger than \$20. If you are sending a gift card or debit card, please verify the available dollars prior to the trip and notify the staff at check in of the funds available. We are having more instances where cards were not activated, do not work, or have an insufficient balance. For Debit cards please be mindful of any automatic payments the traveler may have being automatically withdrawn out of their account such as rent that may affect the trip dollars available. The best option is always cash as this can be exchanged for prepaid cards at stadiums with the balance being available to use anywhere. Bringing cash always gives a very clear picture of what funds are available.

Sign up anytime, 24–hours a day, 7-day a week. Visit our website: abletrektours.com, click on the "Special Needs Tours" link at the top of the page, and then click on the "Sign Up Information" tab. Follow the directions from there.

Three (3) separate pieces of paperwork MUST be completed in order for each Traveler to attend an overnight vacation.

- Application
- Medical Evaluation (Doctor's physical)
- Medical Consent / Waiver Form

(One-day trips require only two forms – Application & Medical Consent / Waiver.)

email, or mail them. Many vacations fill early. We strongly suggest you contact us prior to completing your paperwork to check on trip availability. A deposit of \$100 per trip is required to save a spot on most trip(s).
